**Pray:** Light a candle. Open your devotion with prayer.

**Holy God, you rejoice with us when we celebrate our relationships. When Jesus turned water into wine, he honored the hosts. Teach us to honor our relationships as Jesus did. Amen.**



**Read:** Read the key verses from Sunday's reading.

*<sup>4</sup>And Jesus said to her, "Woman, what concern is that to you and to me? My hour has not yet come."<sup>5</sup>His mother said to the servants, "Do whatever he tells you." (John 2:4-5)*



**Reflect:** Reflect on the scripture summary.

**Jesus performed his first miracle—turning water to wine at a wedding—for his mom.**



**Connect:** Connect in conversation with others in your household or community.

**What was a high point of your day? What was a low point?**

**Tell of a time you needed a little nudge to make a major life move (or even a minor one). Who nudged you? What happened?**

**For the littles: If you could invite Jesus to your birthday party, what gift would you hope he'd bring for all your guests to enjoy?**



**Bless:** Close your devotion with a blessing.

**May Jesus shower you with gifts of the spirit. Amen.**



**Do:** By acting on what we learn, we make God's word come alive. Do the following activity this week.

**Call someone who needs some encouragement. Be the nudge (and support) they need to move through their difficult situation.**
