Baptism Testimony

The story of your personal spiritual journey with Jesus is known as a "testimony." **It can be one paragraph long or a couple pages....it's up to you!** And to help you write it, here are some "thought starters" of things you <u>may</u> want to include in what you write:

- What role (if any) did God and church have in your family growing up?
- What was your picture of God as a child or teen? How has that picture changed in your adult years or since you began coming to The Mission?
- What was your life like before you made the decision to follow Jesus as Lord and Savior of your life?
- . How and when did you decide to commit your life to Jesus Christ?
- Who have been some people who have been instrumental on your spiritual journey that you'd like to thank?
- What "mountain moving" answers to prayer have you experienced?
- How has your faith made a difference in your life?
- How has God been good to you?
- What "seeds of faith" would you like to plant in the hearts and minds of any unbelieving friends or family members who may be attending the baptism?
- Why did you decide you wanted to be baptized this summer?

A Few More Thoughts....

- Be sure to avoid any negative comments about other churches or people as you write your testimony. The goal in your testimony is to give glory to God!
- We are going to ask you to read your testimony out loud when we gather for our baptism event. So please only include things you will feel comfortable sharing with others.
- if a child is being baptized, he or she does <u>not</u> need to share their testimony at our baptism event. We don't want their baptism day to be like an episode of "Fear Factor" for them! In this case, a mom, dad, or guardian can share words on their behalf.
