

UPDATE LETTER FROM HABITAT FOR HUMANITY

Good Afternoon,

It appears that Spring has finally sprung and the warmer weather is here to stay. With the warmer weather comes good news on the construction front. We got the survey results back and now know what we have the ability to build on the lot.

Based on survey results, we are planning on building a split-level house. We are working on finalizing those plans and assuming the township doesn't have any reservations, we should be digging a hole by late May/early June. It typically takes 2-3 weeks for concrete to be poured and the site to be ready for volunteers. As soon as I have a handle on the exact start date, I will be reaching out with volunteer opportunities.

I know there has been a lot of interest from many people about getting involved from a Gift-In-Kind standpoint. As we put together plans, we will also be putting together a budget. If you or anyone you know is interested in gifting labor and/or materials for the build, please reach out to us ASAP so we can begin piecing everything together.

Finally, I spoke recently at Alive Ministries and had several great conversations with members between and after the services. I am more than willing to come out and speak anywhere to provide updates as we get ready to kick this build off.
