### THANKSGIVING BOXES WITH HOPE CITY CHURCH

ABC, along with Hope City Church, has a great opportunity to bless our community by filling Thanksgiving boxes to be distributed in the community. Our church's goal is 50 boxes. Each family is asked to prayerfully fill a box and help distribute the boxes before Thanksgiving. More details will be available soon.



### Operation Christmas Child

Boxes are in the Worship Lobby for you to pick up and pack. Collection Sunday is Nov. 22. We will stack the boxes in the Worship Center and pray over them before sending them out. Church goal: 230 boxes

### FIRST SUNDAY FOOD DRIVE

On the first Sunday of each month, ABC will collect food for the East Tuscaloosa Community Soup Bowl. This Sunday, Nov. 1, the food we collect will go toward Thanksgiving baskets.

Items needed for each basket are:

- 1 small bottle of cooking oil
- 2 cans green beans
- 2 cans corn
- 2 cans sweet potatoes
- 2 cans fruit
- 1 box instant potatoes
- 1 box stuffing mix
- 1 box or can chicken broth
- 1 can cranberry sauce
- 1 box brown sugar
- 1 box cake mix
- 1 can icing

You may also give money toward a box by cash, check, or by going to ETCSB.net. Each box is estimated to cost \$25. Money can be dropped in the offering box in an envelope marked ETCSB. Thank you for your generosity toward those in our community who need help.
