OCTOBER FIELD TRIP INFORMATION

A NOTE TO ALL: Please read the "Field Trip" section in the Wonderland Handbook, so that everyone is on the same page. Prices are for Wonderland preschoolers and

chaperones only. We cannot accommodate older/younger siblings during field trips.

All field trip \$ and forms are due Monday, Oct. 15th. If you would like to chaperone, sign up in your child's classroom. Remember: Any adult accompanying preschoolers (including their own child) must fill out the Washington State Patrol background check form. Drivers chaperoning other children must also turn in copies of a current driver's license, proof of insurance, and registration to the office in order to be eligible.

Teacher Tami & Teacher Jamie's 2-Day 3s: Thurs, Oct. 18th Teacher Tami & Teacher Jamie's 3-Day 3/4s: Fri, Oct. 19th

We will head to Washington Fruit Place (aka Barrett Orchards, aka "The Big Red Barn") on Peck's Canyon Road for a mini-hay maze, a hay ride and an apple treat. Each preschooler will pick out one small pumpkin to leave at school so that we can decorate them at our Pumpkin Parties. The field trip cost is \$4 per child. Chaperones are free.

We will head to "The Union Gap Corn Maze". Each preschooler will pick out a pumpkin to leave at preschool to decorate at our Pumpkin Parties. We will also have hay rides, a corn maze and slides. The cost is \$5 per child. Wonderland will pay the cover charge for the first 6 chaperones who sign up to drive & supervise a small group of children. Other adults will need to pay full admission (\$5) at Schell's.

Pumpkin Parties



It's Pumpkin Party time! Your preschooler can wear his/her costume to school. Children will participate in center time and circle time before going to the Pumpkin Carnival in the Fellowship Hall. Students will then return to their classroom to decorate the pumpkins from their class field trip and have a snack. Please watch for a party sign-up list since all students contribute to the party.

If you would like to provide an extra helping hand during the parties please check with teachers. Parents: You are welcome, but not required, to attend. (Since not every child will have a parent present, you must have the WSP background check completed in order to come.)

*Please keep in mind that we do not want any of our little ones to feel afraid. We only allow "non-scary" and "non-fighty" costumes. We also do not permit any toys or props that are intended to inflict harm.

Examples of INAPPROPRIATE Costumes & Props:

Ghosts, Vampires, Zombies, Monsters, Witches, Skeletons or Frightening Masks

Also, NO Weapons, such as Swords, Guns or Knives.

Childcare is available for younger siblings by signing up at the Noah's Ark nursery window.
