Winter Weather Information

- * We like to get outside for fresh air if the play ground is dry and temperatures are not frigid. Please make sure your child dresses appropriately for the weather and brings a coat, hat and gloves to school.
- * When deciding whether to cancel school, Wonderland takes many factors into consideration; these include the current road and facility conditions, the weather forecast and staff/student safety. Notification will take place through email, the Wonderland Facebook page and the Remind app.
 - If the West Valley School District (WVSD) is closed due to inclement weather, Wonderland will also be closed.
 - If WVSD is delayed, we will make a decision that is safest for our staff and families which may be a late start or cancelation.
- * When arriving to Wonderland be cautious of icy conditions, especially our parking lot. We rely on volunteers to clear the snow and ice from the large parking lot and sidewalks which is a big job!
