Professional recorder player and teacher Pat Petersen will be in Hendersonville, NC, in May, and she will present a 2-hour workshop at our Carolina Mountains Recorder Society meeting on Saturday, May 5, 1-3 PM, in Carolina Village's Village Hall.

Pat Petersen holds an MFA in Early Music Performance from Sarah Lawrence College. A Director Emerita of *Amherst Early Music*, she is a regular faculty member at Amherst's and many other workshops. She performs on recorder and other early winds, and has appeared with the Charleston Symphony Orchestra. She has coached early music ensembles at Wake Forest University and the University of North Carolina at Greensboro. An ARS certified teacher, she teaches recorder, early music, and English country dance in North Carolina and at workshops around the country. She has a passion for playing from facsimiles of early 15th-century music.

The May 5 Pat Petersen workshop is free to current CMRS members. Non-members are most welcome for a fee of \$25 per person – Or for \$30, non-members may attend the workshop and become members of CMRS for the remainder of 2018 (*membership provides access to monthly meetings which will include 2 more professional coaching sessions - see attached 2018 membership form for details about CMRS*).

Pat is also available for private lessons or coaching for small ensembles before or after the May 5 workshop. She charges \$60 an hour for a private lesson (1, 2, or 3 players), and \$75 for a group of 4 or more.

Players wanting private lessons may bring music they are currently studying, or they may request that Pat assist them with a playing or performance skill. Pat would appreciate any information from the student in advance of the lesson.
