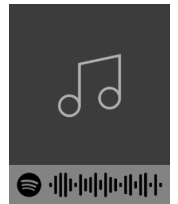

Parent's Guide

Family Time: "God Made Everything"
Genesis 1-2

Big Truth

The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit existed before creation. God created all things and we are subject to His commands.

Main Point

This week we learned that before anything existed, God existed. God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit created everything that exists. From the stars in the sky to the grass beneath our feet, everything belongs to God because He made it. And because God made us, He has the right to tell us how to live. His rules aren't meant to keep us from having fun—they show us what is good and help us know how to live in a way that honors Him.

Family Activity

Look Around!

Take a walk around your house or outside.

Take turns pointing at things God created.

"God made that!"

Then point to something humans made.

"God gave people the ability to make that!"

This is a great opportunity to remind your kids that everything ultimately belongs to God because everything comes from Him.

Read Together:

Read Genesis 1-2 together.

If your child is younger, read slowly and stop to ask:

- Who created everything?
- Who is God?
- How many persons are there in the one true God?
- Who are the three persons of the Trinity?
- Why does God have the right to give us rules?
- Are God's rules meant to hurt us or help us?
- What is one rule God has given us that you want to obey this week?

Memory Verse Key:

Kindergarten: memorize the text in **Green**

1st-2nd Grade: memorize the **Green** and **Red** text

3rd-6th Grade: memorize **Green**, **Red**, and **Black** text
