"Resting Assured—Very Terrified, or What's for Lunch?"

Text: 1 John 5:112-

The Apostle John is writing to church people he deeply loves, and as an elder statesman of the faith, he's laser-focused on what matters most: The true necessary gospel versus false teaching. Who truly belongs to God? Who has eternal life? And how can we know?

- I. Overcoming the World (vv 1-5)
 - A. Faith Produces New Birth
 - Being born of God is not a <u>natural</u> event, but a <u>spiritual</u> rebirth-a work <u>initiated</u> by God, effected by the <u>Holy Spirit</u>, and tied to faith in <u>Christ.</u>
 - B. Faith Results in Love and Obedience
 - 1. If we love God, we will love His *children*.
 - 2. Christlike love requires discernment.
 - 3. Love is not just what you <u>feel</u>—'its what you .<u>do</u>
 And in Christ, we see love at its fullest: ,<u>holy just</u>, and self-giving
 - 4. So what does *obedience* look like? (v3a)"that we keep His *commandments*.
 - C. How do we overcome the world?
 - 1. To overcome in the biblical sense is to <u>remain</u> faithful, <u>resist</u> evil, and <u>stand</u> <u>firm</u> in Christ—trusting that His victory is yours <u>by faith</u>.
 - 2. Through faith in Christ, we overcome. We're freed to <u>love</u>, to <u>obey</u>, and to <u>live</u> differently.

II. The Testimony Concerning the Son of God

- A. The testimony of three witnesses.
 - 1. Water perhaps referring to Jesus' baptism, where the Father <u>affirmed</u> His identity (Matt. 3:17
 - 2. Blood Referring to His <u>atoning</u> <u>death</u> on the cross. (Matthew 27:54, Hebrews 9:14,)
 - 3. The Spirit Who testifies *inwardly* and truthfully (Mark 1:12, Luke 1:35, Acts 10:37-38)
- B. God's Testimony Is Greater
 - The Father Himself has testified to the Son—through Jesus' <u>baptism</u>, His
 crucifixion, his <u>resurrection</u> and ascension, and the ongoing work of the Holy
 Spirit.

III. Reflect and Respond

- A. If you have the son, rest assured.
 - 1. Continue your journey towards Christlikeness. Be amazed and awestruck, and adore the Triune God.
 - 2. <u>Confess</u> and be <u>convicted</u> to repentance by your shortfalls and transgressions.
 - 3. Gain *confidence* and *comfort* through God's promises in Scripture.
 - 4. Be *thankful* and rejoice in the gift of your saving faith.
 - 5. Be bold but reverent to <u>petition</u> God to <u>supply</u> your needs and the needs of others.
 - 6. *Humbly* love God and love one another.
