Ann Carlin Ozegovic

August 26, 1942—December 18, 2018

Ann was born August 26, 1942 in Salina, Kansas; the daughter of Jack W. and Hazel L. (Johnson) Carlin. She grew up on the family dairy farm near Smolan, Kansas and was an active 4-H member throughout her youth. She attended Smolan Grade School and graduated from Lindsborg Rural High School. She earned her BA in Journalism in 1964 at Kansas State University and her MFA in photography in 1978 at Central Michigan University.

She married Jack Ozegovic in Traverse City, Michigan on December 20, 1969. He preceded her in death on December 15, 2018, three days before she died.

Ann lived in Traverse City for 25 years. She worked as a journalist at the National Music Camp at Interlochen, Michigan and at the Traverse City Record-Eagle as a reporter and Arts Editor. Later she served as the executive director of the Traverse City Arts Council and as a freelance photographer for Northwestern Michigan College.

In 1989, they moved to Lawrence, Kansas and she worked as a special assistant to the Kansas Secretary of Human Resources. Ann finished her public service career as an employment specialist at the Lawrence Workforce Center, retiring in 2004. She loved singing and sang in the Lawrence Civic Choir's alto section for 27 years. She also supported and campaigned for many candidates, including her brother, former Kansas Governor, John Carlin.

Survivors include her brother, John Carlin and wife Lynn, a niece, a nephew, a grand niece, and two grand nephews, and many beloved friends in Lawrence and around the country.

She is preceded in death by her parents and husband Jack.

A memorial service was held for Ann & Jack on February 2, 2019 at Salemsborg Lutheran Church. A reception was held immediately following the service at the C&W Ranch. Memorials can be made to the Salemsborg Church Memorial Fund.

The family and friends of Jack and Ann Carlin Ozegovic wish to express their sincere thanks to Pastor Bill Peterson and all who helped in any way with the joint memorial service, which was held on February 2 at Salemsborg. 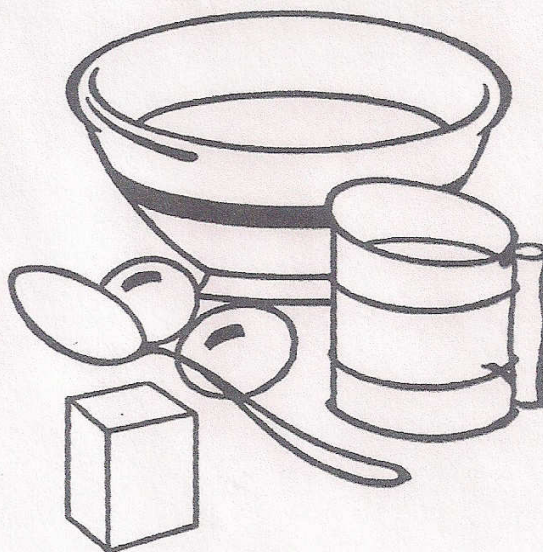

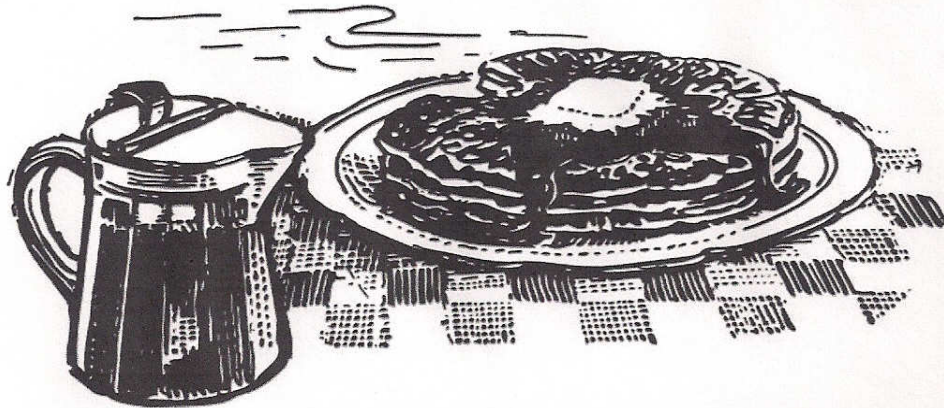
RECIPE REQUIREMENTS
