Ministry Updates



Backpack Buddies is a ministry that we do here at FBC where we provide bags of food to 51 local students between Russell Elementary and Huntington Middle Schools to help through the weekends. Each bag is filled with 5-7 ready-to-eat or easy-to-prepare meals and snacks. For most of 2025 and the beginning of 2026, we had halted this ministry, but it's back up and running through the school year!

- In February, we packed 200 Bags, totaling 1400 Meals/snacks.
- In March, we packed 202 Bags, totaling 1414 meals/snacks.
- In April and May, we are preparing to pack 306 bags to finish out the last 6 weeks of school for these students. That's 1442 meals and snacks!

This ministry requires little time but the impact and reach for our community are huge! With just 7 volunteers packing bags, it takes on average, less than 1 hour per month to prepare them all. If you're interested in being involved in this ministry in the future, reach out!
