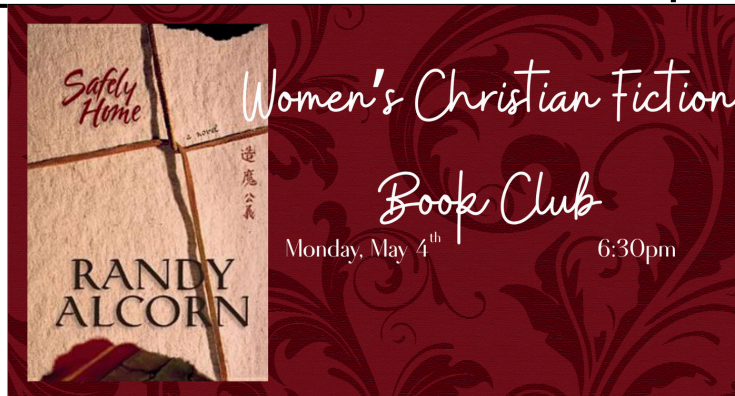

When my son was a young boy, I built him a fort similar to this one. I had never built anything before, but I felt like I could, and I enjoyed the learning experience. The structure was 8 by 8 feet and stood on 4x4 posts. It was level but not square, though it probably could have withstood a hurricane. I used high-quality wood, pressure-treated posts, and a ton of nails. My son loved it, and later I discovered he had added a bathroom. Thankfully, the hole didn't compromise the structure. As I look back, I can think of things now that I would do differently. Rather than building a fort, I'm now building a life. I'm trying to use high-quality materials and a ton of nails while keeping it level and, hopefully, square. My goal is that one day the Lord will be able to say, "Well done, good and faithful servant" (Matthew 25:21). That should be all of our goals. Oh, how we fall short. If you had looked at that fort I built, you might have been impressed, but if you were a builder, you might have laughed. What people see in us might seem impressive, but in reality, we are nothing but sinful people saved by the grace of God. And in the end, every crown will be laid at His feet (Revelation 4:10-11).
