Perhaps they enjoy sitting across from each other, talking about their family, friends, the Lord, their blessings, their problems, or life in general. Facing one another can communicate attention, encourage emotional connection, promote honesty and openness, help with listening, and strengthen intimacy. What’s important to communicate is this: “I am here with you. I want to hear you. What matters to you matters to me.” The same is true in our relationship with God. He invites us to sit with Him, talking with Him and listening to Him. In Psalm 116:1-2, the psalmist speaks personally about loving the Lord because “He has heard my voice” and “He has inclined His ear to me.” Maybe we should invite the Lord to pull up a chair and sit with us. Ministry Updates

- Recent ministry trips to Morehouse, MO and Bland have gone well, with teams working together to serve and meet needs.
- After much prayer and counsel, the family plans to step away from Haysi and relocate to East Tennessee.
- Mission Element is shifting toward more direct, field-based missionary work, with a primary focus on reaching Appalachian Trail hikers with the Gospel.
- The vision includes creating a hiker hostel and ministry base near the trail where hikers can receive meals, showers, laundry, rides, and other practical help while building relationships and opening doors for Gospel conversations.
- A promising property has become available just 1.3 miles from the Appalachian Trail, with space for both the family and the future hostel.
- Mission Element is seeking to raise \$500,000 in one-time donations to purchase the property, construct the hostel, and prepare it for ministry.
