

7: SHARE - Simple & Strategic

So how can we engage others in a spiritual conversation? Today we learn some simple and strategic ways to talk with others about what matters most.

Start a Spiritual Conversation with those closest in your circles of influence.

- Communicate Value. "You are valuable, created in the image of God. I'm a follower of Jesus. and I would love to talk with you more about Him."
- Ask a probing question. "What's your spiritual background like? "Do you ever think about spiritual things?" Do you consider yourself a FOLLOWER of Jesus?" "What happens when you die?"
 - Typically, people will respond by sharing 1) they are a Christian, fully relying on Jesus 2) a Christian (without having evidence of fruit), 3) other claims good works, many ways to God, other religion, or atheist.
- **D** Bad News/Good News: Help 'em see sin & need for Savior.

²⁶ From one man he made all the nations, that they should inhabit the whole earth; and he marked out their appointed times in history and the boundaries of their lands. [GOD - created all things]²⁷ God did this so that they would seek him and perhaps reach out for him and find him, though he is not far from any one of us. ²⁸ 'For in him we live and move and have our being.' As some of your own poets have said, 'We are his offspring.' ²⁹ "Therefore since we are God's offspring [MAN - created in God's image], we should not think that the divine being is like gold or silver or stone—an image made by human design and skill. ³⁰ In the past God overlooked such ignorance, but now he commands all people everywhere to repent. [SIN - people are to turn away] ³¹ For he has set a day when he will judge the world with justice by the man he has appointed. He has given proof of this to everyone by raising him from the dead." [JESUS & JUDGMENT]

Share your Story (in 3 minutes): B.C. days ➤ trusting Jesus ➤ NOW

- * Don't chase rabbits & Don't answer what you don't know. Don't fall for this trap. Instead, if the question seems legitimate, say, "I'm not sure. I'll take some time to research that and get back to you."
- Challenge to follow Jesus. Most spiritual conversations won't end with the person ready to trust Jesus that moment. Plant the seed, be patient, point them to read Scripture, and be ready to answer questions.

Acts 17:32-34 NIV

³² When they heard about the resurrection of the dead, <u>some of them sneered</u>, but others said, "**We want to hear you again** on this subject." ³³ At that, Paul left the Council. ³⁴ <u>Some of the people became followers</u> of Paul and believed.
