As of December 5th, the Pledge Drive currently is 75% of our \$425,000 goal.



Do you love to send and receive Christmas cards? Has the cost of postage made it prohibitive? Well, the St. Stephen's Christmas Card exchange is back for its second year.




#### **CHRISTMAS FLOWERS**
