**Harvest of Love, Sunday, November 23** - Plan on attending our annual Harvest of Love service and meal. Bring a dish to share at the meal, which will begin at 11:30AM in the HUB. The church will provide the turkey and dressing. Our *Harvest of Love offering* is a special offering over and above our regular offerings for the day. Our goal this year is \$25,000. Of that total, \$12,500 will be used to retire our long term debt. \$6,250 will be given to the Taylorville Food Pantry, which is receiving heavy use at present. And \$6,250 will be used for a couple of projects in the garage. First, we're adding a garage door on the north end of the building to access storage we have in that area. And the second project is to create an indoor playground on the other end of the garage. We've been thinking about this for several years. It will allow us to have special events for our Kids Ministry and will create a space to have special outreach events as well. This offering will really only start the project.
