STUDENT MINISTRY (Jr. & Sr. High) meets on Sunday nights from 5:30 to 7:30pm in the Student Center during the school year. Doors open at 5:00pm. Group begins at 5:30pm.

COMMUNION is served at the end of each service and is open to everyone who believes in Jesus. Communion cups are available on the tables in the foyer. Please place in waste baskets located in the foyer after service. Thank you.
