



PASTOR PAUL'S PARAGRAPHS

Dear Members and Friends of Sweetwater,

Blessings! It is hard to believe that we find ourselves in the Christmas season.

The greatest news in human history is the news that Jesus Christ was born in Bethlehem. The Angel of the Lord declared to the shepherds in **Luke 2:10**, "Fear not, for behold, I bring you **good news** of great joy that will be for all the people." (ESV) News is an acronym that stands for North, East, West, and South. The good news of Jesus Christ is to be spread north, east, west, and south. Note three things about the **"good news"** of Christ's birth and the redemption of mankind.

First, the Christmas story is **TRUTHFUL** news. **Ephesians 1:13** states, "In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation" **Billy Graham** once stated, "Christmas is not a myth, not a tradition, not a dream. It is a glorious reality."

Secondly, the Christmas story is **JOYFUL** news. The meaning and message of Christmas fills our hearts with joy. **Isaiah 12:2 and 3** declares, "Behold, God is my salvation; I will trust, and not be afraid: for the Lord JEHOVAH is my strength and my song; he also is become my salvation. Therefore with joy shall ye draw water out of the wells of salvation."

Thirdly, the Christmas story is **WONDERFUL** news. This news is wonderful because our Savior Jesus Christ has come to save us from our sins. **First John 4:14** reminds us of the following, "And we have seen and do testify that the Father sent the Son to be the Savior of the world."

One of my favorite hymns is "Tell Me the Story of Jesus" by Fanny Crosby. The first stanza is as follows:



"Tell me the story of Jesus, Write on my heart every word; Tell me the story most precious, Sweetest that ever was heard.

Tell how the angels, in chorus, Sang as they welcomed His birth, "Glory to God in the highest! Peace, and good tidings to earth."
