








In August, nearly 40 of our students and leaders joined thousands of others at the Tim Tebow FCA Fields of Faith event in Aiken, SC. Tim shared the gospel powerfully, and our students were challenged to stand boldly for Christ in their generation.

### Turning the World Upside Down

This month in youth, we're walking through a series called Peculiar People, where we are studying the lives of the twelve disciples. These were not the men most people would have chosen—fishermen, tax collectors, zealots, and even doubters. Yet Jesus called them, equipped them, and used them to turn the world upside down (Acts 17:6). Their stories remind us that God doesn't call the qualified; He qualifies the called. Our students are discovering that following Jesus isn't about having it all together—it's about surrender, obedience, and letting God use ordinary lives for His extraordinary mission. If Jesus could use a handful of imperfect men to change history, then He can—and will—use this generation too.



As a church, we must pause and ask ourselves: Are we truly making disciples who live differently, or are we simply doing church as usual? The next generation is not looking for a faith that is safe, comfortable, or easy. They are longing to see a faith that is bold, authentic, and lived out in everyday life. They don't just need more programs; they need models—men and women who show them what it looks like to follow Jesus wholeheartedly in a world pulling them the other direction. The youth of Sweetwater are watching us. What they see in our lives will either confirm or contradict the message we preach. The church that raises up a generation with a sent faith—one that goes, serves, and makes disciples—will be a church that turns the world upside down again.

Dear Church Family,


Our children are growing in the Word! Please help them to continue growing through prayer, reading the Bible with them, and being an active part of our church family.




