Why did Matthew throw a party for Jesus?

- To introduce his friends to Jesus.
- He is leaving the lifestyle of a tax collector.
- He is going to follow Jesus.

Ephesians 2:1-2

The Gospel is not for those who think they are good, but for those who know they are bad.

The three pillars of Judaism: prayer, almsgiving, fasting

- Fasting reminds us that we can go without.
- Fasting connects us to those who have very little.
- Fasting helps us remember the sacrifice of Jesus.
