**Luke 6:17-7:23**

**Luke 6:17-26**

The word for “blessed” means how “truly happy” you are.

There was a reason Jesus says blessed are the poor, hungry, weeping...because they were persecuted for following Jesus.

**2 Timothy 3:12**

Be persecuted for the right reason: being a follower of Jesus Christ.

In Luke, there are four “beatitudes” followed by the four “woes”.

**Luke 6:27-30**

These verses are the highlight of Jesus’ sermon.

Jesus speaks about what sets His followers apart:

- loving your enemies
- those that hate you

**Luke 7:1-10**

The Roman Centurion (the enemy) had the right view of the relationship between God and man.

**Luke 7:11-23**

- The widow had no protection or provision.
- Jesus had compassion on her.
