## Romans 2:21b-24

No one rejects Jesus because we're sinners – they reject Jesus because Christian folks are sinners & pretend, we're not.

Religious pride creates a hard heart.

You can learn with your heart or with your elbow.

- The heart says...before I apply this to anyone else, God, I give you permission to take this truth, this law, this righteous idea and apply it to the inner most part of me.
- The elbow says, are you getting this? Are you listening?

A hard heart leads to a hypocritical life

2 Corinthians 12:9 NIV

Romans 1:25-29

- 1. Am I teachable?
  - Do I tend to cling to right answers?
  - Do I listen to that still small voice of the Holy Spirit that says you have more to learn?
  - Are we listening with our heart or elbow?
- 2. Have I let religion harden my heart?
  - Do I want the right answer or right relationship?
- 3. Does my life evidence the Spirit of God?
  - The evidence is: Love, Joy, peace, patience the fruit of the Spirit.
