**The Turning Point**  
**Luke 9:51**

**Before, Luke focused on the works of Jesus; after, Luke focused on the words of Jesus.**

**From the miracles Jesus performed to the message Jesus spoke.**

**We turn from the revelation of Jesus Christ to the rejection of Jesus Christ...culminating at the cross.**

**Luke 10:1-24**

**Why did Jesus send out the seventy?**

- Old Testament model
  - Seventy Elders (Ezekiel 18; 24:9)
  - Twelve Apostles (twelve tribes)
- The Harvest is plentiful
  - need workers who pray

**What did Jesus say these seventy should expect?**

- lambs among wolves
- travel light
- preach/heal
- rejection

**Luke 10:25-37**

- Great question (v.25)
  - Bad motivation
  - Wrong belief
- The law says “do this and you will live” ...grace says “live and you will do this.”
  - The law was never meant to cleanse you, it was meant to convict you. (Romans 3:20)
- Jesus made the most hated person among the Jews the hero of His story.
  - His own disciples wanted to torch the Samaritans. (Luke 9:5-55)
  - The Lawyer wouldn’t even say “Samaritan.” (v.37)

**What are the takeaways and applications?**

- Unexpected help from an unexpected source
- Your existence is an answer to a problem.
- This is an opportunity in the midst of adversity.
