# THE GOSPEL STORY God Wants to Be With You Exodus 38-40; 1 Corinthians 6:19-20

#### **Exodus in Three Parts:**

- Domination by Egypt (Exodus 1-12)
- Liberation from Egypt (Exodus 13-18)
- Revelation after Egypt (Exodus 19-40)

### Exodus - Chapters 35-40:

"Take Two" – Israel gets it right and obeys God.

### **Exodus – Chapter 38:**

- Exodus 38:1-2
- The Bronze Altar where the blood of sacrifices was shed:
  - "Without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness of sins" (Hebrews 9:22b)
- The Wash Basin (laver) of Bronze:
  - Exodus 38:8
  - Made from an offering of mirrors
    - 1 Timothy 1:17
    - Why is bronze used in the articles of the tabernacle (i.e. The Altar)?
- The Courtyard:
  - o Exodus 38:21-29
  - Shekels are not coins, but a measurement of weight.
    - This offering in modern-day terms:
      - 5 million dollars of gold
      - 4 million dollars of silver
      - 7 thousand dollars of bronze
      - The total offering was approximately 10 million dollars in precious metals.

# **Exodus – Chapter 39:**

- Exodus 39:1, 5, 7, 21, 26, 29, 31
- Notice the repeated phrase, "As the Lord commanded Moses."
- We learn a few things from the Israelites:
  - What <u>not</u> to do
    - 1 Corinthians 10:6-8
  - o What to do
    - gathered in unity to worship God
    - gave generously to God
    - fully devoted to God

- The Priest's Clothing:
  - There were 8 articles of clothing and 4 of those articles were worn <u>only</u> by the High Priest.
    - Ephod (Exodus 39:2-7)
    - Breastplate (Exodus 39:8-21)
    - Crown (Exodus 28:36-38)
    - Blue Robe (Exodus 39:22-26)
  - The High Priest removed his royal/golden garments only for the sacrifice on the Day of Atonement (Yom Kippur – Leviticus 16:4)
    - Philippians 2:6-8
    - **Exodus 39:42-43**

## **Exodus – Chapter 40:**

- Exodus 40:1-2
- The dedication of the Tabernacle the place where God dwells
  - Exodus chapter 40 is where the whole old covenant begins. Up until now it's all been in the planning stages.
  - Also up until now, "The Tent of Meeting" and "The Tabernacle" were two separate places.
    - Now they are combined because the two are now one (Exodus 40:1), where the glory of the Lord will rest.
    - **Exodus 40:3, 16-18**
    - **Exodus 40:20-23**
- After all was completed, "Then the cloud covered the tent of meeting, and the glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle." (Exodus 40:34)
  - O Why? Why is this so important?
    - Exodus 25:8
  - God exercises His Divine Determination to be with us.
    - 1 Corinthians 6:19-20
