Three Lessons Learned from a Donkey Ride:

Lesson 1: Jesus is more attractive than religion (John 12:12-13)

- Religion always emphasizes the outward, Jesus always emphasizes the heart.
- Religion is about what you <u>can't</u> do, Jesus is about what you <u>can</u> do.
- Religion puts up barriers, Jesus tears down barriers.
- Religion says, "work your way," Jesus says, "I am the Way."

Lesson 2: Scripture is more reliable than opinion (John 12:14-16)

- Opinion said:
 - Jesus was not from God (John 9:16)
 - Jesus was a prophet (John 4:19)
 - Jesus was demon-possessed (John 10:20)
- Scripture says:
 - Jesus is the King (John 12:13-14; Psalm 118:26; Zechariah 9:9)
- Why did Jesus come into Jerusalem riding on a donkey?
 - The donkey affirmed His identity as their King (John 12:15).
 - The donkey ride indicated that the King comes to bring peace.

Luke 19:41-44

Lesson 3: Following Jesus is more important than observing Jesus (John 12:16-19)

- John records the responses of four groups of people:
 - The disciples (v.16)
 - The eye witnesses to Lazarus being raised from the dead (v.17)
 - Those that heard from the eye witnesses (v.18)
 - The religious leaders (v.19)
