THE GOSPEL STORY THE GOSPEL OF JOHN – Good News for a Change John 21:15-19 – Part Two Pastor Ron Swor – 5.7.23

We have all heard the saying, "Failure is <u>not</u> an option!" But, in fact, it's more than an option, it's a certainty and it can be one of the surest stepping stones to victory.

In John 21:15-19, Jesus restores Peter to Himself and back to useful service.

If you have ever failed I think these principles will encourage you:

- 1. Love Jesus deeply. (vv.15-17)
 - A review from last Sunday:
 - Jesus restores Peter privately and publicly.
 - Jesus establishes a culture of restoration, a culture absent of shame.
 - Jesus cuts right to the heart of the matter, "Peter, do you love me?"
 - o Not "Peter, do you know me?" "Peter, do you have correct theology?"
 - \circ The issue is always about your heart, "do you love me?" (Proverbs 4:23)
- 2. Serve Jesus without compromise. (v.18)
- 3. Follow Jesus always. (v.19)
