Joshua 3 and 4 - Remember

I. The Gospel Story Series, we're looking for:

- A. Patterns from Hebrew culture and their style of writing that help us understand and know God and scripture better.
- B. Looking for where we can see pictures, symbols or words that point us to coming Messiah, Jesus.

II. Biblical Context leading up to the book of Joshua

- 1. Brief recap of history and Moses' leadership
- 2. Story: Have you ever tried to lead a group of rebellious people?
- 3. Kids Town lesson point: The Israelites Rebellion revealed a belief that God had failed to take care of them and would fail in the future.
- 4. Joshua Ch. 1 Joshua being the "New Moses" and recommit to "Listening and obeying" their covenant with God.
- 5. Joshua Ch. 2 Joshua sends spies into Jericho and meet Rahab

III. Read parts of Chapter 3

- 1. Chapter 3: 5-10, 14-17 (Map)
- 2. Chapter 4:1-3, 14-18 (Compare Moses and Joshua's leadership)
- 3. Chapter 4 verses 20-24 **First time Israel is referred to as a Nation

IV. Looking further into patterns, we see that God Continues To...

- 1. Extend Mercy Allowing them to reach the Promised Land
- 2. Build relational Trust "Listen and obey"
- 3. Ask for Obedience
- 4. Show His Inexplicable power (Ch. 4:23)
- 5. Promises come with Battles (The rest of the book of Joshua)
- 6. Want us to Remember (vs 24)

Remembering helps us to live out Joshua Ch 1:9 -Be Strong and Courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go"

V. Looking for Jesus in Joshua chapters 3 and 4

- 1. Joshua means Yeshua in Hebrew. Jesus also is derived from the Hebrew name Yeshua.
- 2. Ark of the Covenant
 - a) How God would dwell in the Old Testament
 - b) The construction of the Ark
 - c) Tabernacle Courtyard
 - d) Tabernacle Tent
 - e) The Significance of the Ark of the Covenant
- 3. The Jordan River- Jesus was Baptized in the Jordan River and began his public ministry acting as the High Priest, performing miracles, providing The Way to salvation.
- 4. Freedom Israelites being freed from their slavery in Egypt to us being free from our slavery to sin
- 5. Faith in God's Plan It is God who makes a way forward through his power and mercy, our job is to be strong, be courageous, "Listen and Obey".
