Romans 6:8-14 - Dead to Sin, Alive to God

I - Context of Romans:

- 1. **Author:** Apostle Paul to the Jewish and Non-Jewish followers of Jesus living in Rome.
- 2. **Purpose of the letter:** To UNIFY the Roman church by teaching what the core beliefs (Doctrine) are in following Jesus.
- 3. **Why was this important?** When the church is unified, the Gospel can spread faster!

II - Recap of Chapters:

- 1. Chapters 1-4: ALL of humanity trapped in sin and guilty before a Righteous God. Through faith in Christ, we are justified (made right with God).
- 2. Chapters 5-8: God creates a new humanity in Jesus Christ. Following Jesus means leaving the old life and entering a new life in Christ. Our Union with Christ should be transforming our lives.

III - Romans 6: 5-7 (*Listen to Pastor Ron's message last week)

- 1. We are united with Christ: in death and resurrection.
- 2. The "old self" was crucified with Christ.
- 3. No longer controlled by or enslaved to sin.
- 4. We've been set free from sin but where have we set up our "spiritual residency"?

IV - Romans 6: 8-11

- 1. Again, we are united with Christ: in death and resurrection.
- 2. Because of Jesus' resurrection, death has no claim on Him!
- 3. Jesus submitted to the death of sin and is now alive, honoring the Father
- 4. Our Union with Christ Dead to sin, Alive to God

V - Romans 6: 12-14

- 1. No longer swimming in our sin
- 2. Our bodies as an instrument of wickedness
- 3. Our bodies as an instrument of righteousness
- 4. Not living under the law, but living under Grace
