• Solomon recognizes the nature and character of God.

1 Kings 8:24-26

• Solomon recognizes God as the Maker and Keeper of promises.

1 Kings 8:27-30

• Solomon asks God to dwell in this place and honor those who seek Him.

1 Kings 8:31-32

Solomon prays that God would hear when people take a vow at the Temple.

1 Kings 8:33-34

• God would hear when His people are defeated.

1 Kings 8:35-40

• God would hear in times of plague and famine.

1 Kings 8:41-43

• God would hear when a foreigner prays.

1 Kings 8:44-53

• God would hear when Israel goes to battle and is made captive by their enemy.
