#### Then:

- 1. Establishing a physical kingdom
- 2. Worship centered around <u>sacrifice</u> through the <u>tabernacle</u>
- 3. The conquest was people and property
- 4. The command was: <u>subdue</u> the land and <u>make war</u>

#### Now:

- 1. Building a <u>spiritual kingdom</u>
- 2. Worship centers around the <u>savior</u> through the <u>church</u>
- 3. The conquest is <u>souls</u> and <u>salvation</u>
- 4. The command is: spread the gospel and make disciples
