John 8: Challenging Jesus' Identity

Outline: Jesus, I Am

John 8:12-16 John 8:19 John 18:25, 27-30

Jesus tells us he is God's messiah by carefully choosing his words

- 1. Jesus knows his identity
- When Jesus was asked who He was, He knew how to respond
- When we are asked who we are, how do we respond? What is the first thing we go to when someone asks us to describe ourselves?

2. Jesus states his identity

- Jesus uses the I Am statements throughout the book of John and chapter 8 to signify who He was in a time when God's people were specifically asking Him.
- "I am the light of the world." 8:12
- Two weeks ago with "I am the bread of life." 6:35
- "Before Abraham was, I am." 8:58

Jesus was telling His people exactly who he was through the many I am statements Jesus makes in chapter 8.

3. Jesus fulfills his Identity

- Jesus fulfilled his identity when he was lifted up as the sacrifice for our sins. 8:28-30
- There is great symbolism in Jesus being lifted up. This was part of his identity as God's son to be lifted up for the benefit of all.
- Our identity as sons and daughters of the father is to lift up his son in glory.

• Have we taken the time to know God, and be known for him?

Do we state our identity in Christ?

• We are called to speak up when our identity is challenged.

Do we fulfill our identity to glorify God?

• What do we do on Monday, through Saturday that fulfills our identity?
