Joshua 10:1-4 [NIV]

Why was King Adoni-Zedek afraid?

- This was a conquest of judgement, not plunder...
- ...and the surrender of the strong Gibeonites.

Joshua 10:5-6 [NIV]

We all need a camp Gilgal

- A place of refuge and safety
- A place of remembrance (Jos. 3:20)
- A place of radical obedience (Jos. 5:2)
- A place where the shame of sin was rolled away (Jos. 5:8)
