What a busy two months we have had! Alyssa received a wonderful birthday present in the form of an email stating that we had been granted visas to work in the United Kingdom. Of course, we had other ways to celebrate her birthday as well! That was on Friday, 16 June, and by the next Wednesday, we were on the plane to fly to London. We had a few days to settle in before the youth group from our home church arrived in London to help us with outreach projects throughout South London. Over the two weeks that Temple Baptist youth group was with us, we reached around 30,000 homes with the Gospel, participated in 5 youth outreach events, and saw 10 people saved! The capstone to this trip was the event that we held on Friday night at our Sunbeam Mission. The teens organized and acted out a 5 part Bible experience that led visitors from Creation and the Fall to the Cross and the Resurrection, telling the story of Jesus throughout. It was an amazing sight to see everything come together over the course of three days, and even better to hear of those expressing their faith in Jesus Christ for salvation. We had about 100 visitors to this unique presentation, and several saved as a result. We worked the youth group until they were ragged, but their attitudes and spirits stayed positive, in spite of all the train delays and changed plans. We love having groups come visit us, not only because of the potential impact of having 30,000 flyers distributed, or the salvations that happen, but especially because of the potential for God to move in the hearts of the group members. It remains our prayer that God would lead some of those who visit us to return, whether part-time or full-time!

As we look forward to the next few months, we will be busy getting back in to the rhythms of ministry here in London. We have had many visitors over the last few months, and follow up is key! There are also several that have been saved and attending regularly, and we look forward to getting them involved with the discipleship opportunities that we have throughout the week.

Even though events in London have brought about a lot of uncertainty or fear, many people have actually been fairly open on the streets. There have been many opportunities to talk with people on the streets about the Gospel. We thank you for your prayers, we truly could not do it without them!
