Silent Meditation
Use this time to connect more deeply with God’s love through the event of Jesus’ surrender and sacrifice. Below are some suggested guides during this time of contemplation. As you breathe in, you may say the words in your head, “**Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God,**” and as you breathe out, “**Have mercy on me, a sinner.**”

You may invite God to guide you closer to Him, prayerfully considering these questions: “How does the extent of God’s love shown through Jesus’ suffering affect how I might view sacrificial love in my own life?” and “How does Jesus’ example lead me to acts of love for those around me?”

Jesus taught “Most assuredly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it produces much grain.” (John 12:24). Ask Jesus to show you areas in your life that need to die so that you may live in the fullness of the resurrection life He has for you.
