

ALICIA WINTER SCHOLARSHIP

Description: The Alicia Winter Work-Scholarship is awarded to women vulnerable to violence or victims of patriarchal (domestic) violence or violence generated by the armed conflict. This scholarship is awarded in return for her service as a student assistant in one of the institution's facilities, which also guarantees that students have a safe space.

Considerations:

- A. The scholarship grants one hundred percent (100%) of the tuition fee. Regular tuition for undergraduate programs offered for one (1) academic period, subject to extension to one (1) additional period. (It is not for life or cumulative with other internal educational aid.)
- B. Up to three (3) scholarships will be awarded per academic period, subject to availability. A total of up to six (6) scholarships per year. Under no circumstances will more than six (6) scholarships be awarded annually.
- C. The student assistant's service time will be twenty (20) hours per week during the academic period, according to the needs of the area where they are assigned.
- D. The activities carried out by student assistants (whether related to their studies or not) will be supervised by the person responsible for the area where they are assigned and will be provided with ongoing psychological support by the Student Welfare Department.
- E. The scholarship does not imply any type of employment relationship with the institution.

This scholarship has its application process (call) and requirements. Applicants must complete the selection process, and then be referred to the institutional scholarship committee, which reviews the applications and awards the respective scholarship.

Unireformada makes efforts to maintain this scholarship with its own resources and seeks to fund small grants from the institutions that partner with us. Currently, we can only offer one scholarship per semester; we hope to guarantee what we have long hoped for (six scholarships per year) in the future.
