Confident that God justifies us by grace through faith, let us confess our sin.

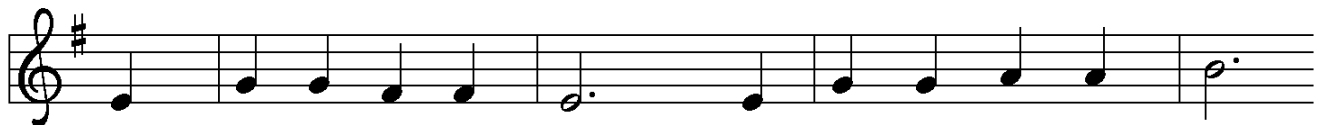
Silence is kept for reflection.

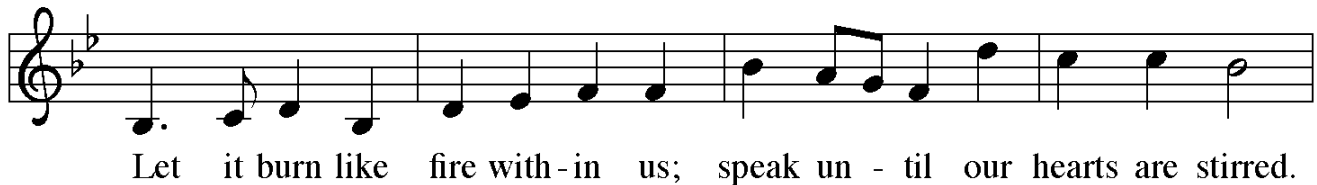

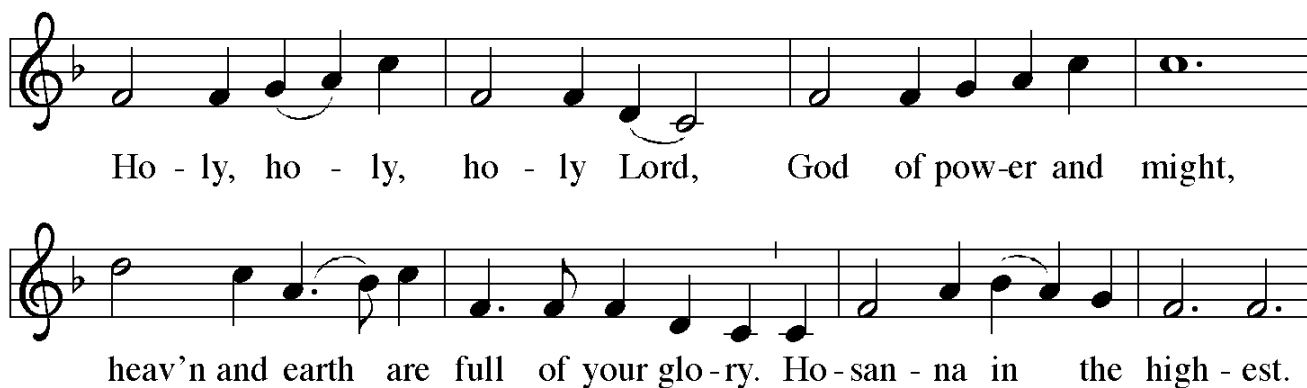

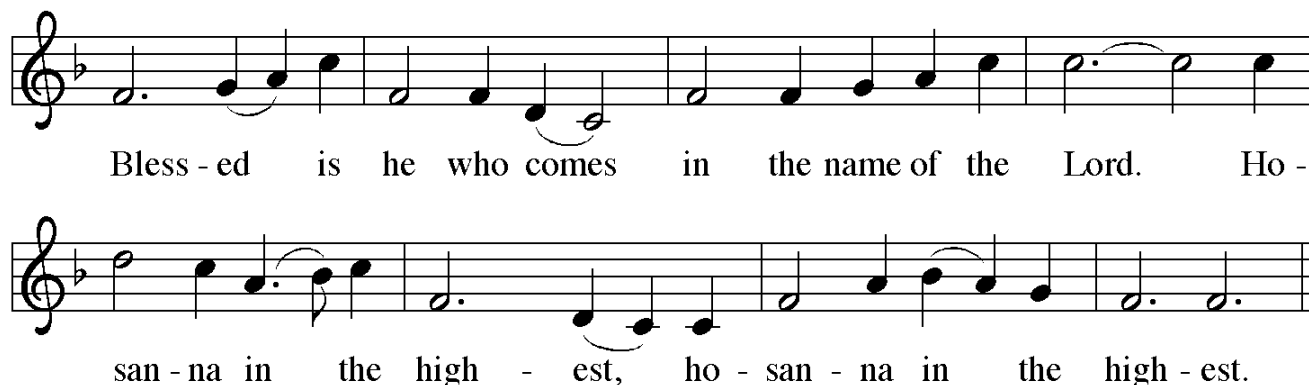
We lift them to the Lord.

WORDS OF INSTITUTION
