

Message from our Pastor

[first published in July 17 Parish e-Newsletter] Dear Parish Family,

Within ancient Jewish biblical tradition, hospitality is deeply ingrained in the culture and seen as an essential dimension of both the culture and spirituality. It's a fundamental value where visitors are treated with utmost respect and generosity, often likened to welcoming a gift from God. St. Benedict, in Chapter 53 of his Rule, deepens this Jewish tradition of hospitality, writing: "All guests who present themselves are to be welcomed as Christ." Hospitality is an important extension of our faith, providing a meaningful way in which we treat others with reverence and respect.

The first reading for this weekend's Mass [July 20] is known as the Hospitality of Abraham and comes from Genesis 18. In the narrative, three strangers approach the entrance of his tent seeking food and shelter, and hospitality is offered to them. They are later revealed to be angels, and Sarah is later blessed with a son, Isaac, as a reward. The scene is often depicted in the Orthodox iconographic tradition as the Old Testament Trinity, emphasizing unity and equality, as well as the importance of showing love and generosity to strangers.

Hospitality is in many ways the heart of Partners in the Gospel and at the heart of what we are all about as a Parish Family. This past weekend [July 13; see below], we celebrated the commissioning of the PFAC (Parish Family Advisory Council) and PFLT (Parish Family Leadership Team), both essential consultative bodies for Partners in the Gospel. Both are comprised of members from all three parishes and two schools that constitute our Parish Family, and will be key to the next phase, in which we answer the question: Who are we?

As we move forward, welcoming each other into our own tents as Abraham welcomed the three strangers with warm hospitality, let us all strive to see and open our hearts and lives to Christ, who is present in everyone.




