Pastor's Message

[first appeared in November 13 Parish e-Newsletter]

Dear Parish Family,

As many of you know, we are currently in stage 2 of the Partners in the Gospel, One Parish Planning process. The central question that we are exploring during this stage is "Who are we?" The first part of stage 2 was the surveys that were completed last month [in October]. With over 1,400 surveys completed between our three parishes, I feel that it was an overwhelming success! Thanks to everyone who participated.

The second part of stage 2 will be two separate synodal listening sessions, the first of which will happen in our parishes over the next few weeks. [Thank you to all who attended the sessions at St. Martin of Tours on November 23; see next column for dates of remaining sessions.] The focus of the first round of synodal listening sessions will be exploring our gifts and charisms that constitute our parish family. We will reflect on who we are as a parish family—our people, ministries, gifts, and opportunities.

As we learn to grow and develop the many capacities in becoming a synodal church, these synodal listening sessions are critical dimensions in this process. The word **synodality** means **walking together**, and it is a way to encourage and invite all of the people of God to an active and conscious participation in the life and mission of the Church. Pope Francis wrote that it is "precisely this path of synodality which God expects of the Church for the third millennium" and that it is a "constitutive element of the Church."

Synodality, in terms of the conversion of mentalities and structures that it implies, is the distinct way of being Church that God wills for us to become. Synodality envisions a Church that listens and invites all ecclesial subjects, all of the faithful, to a full and active participation in its life and mission. It is promising to note that Pope Leo XIV is deeply


