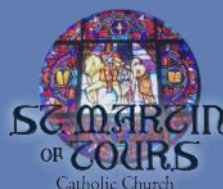

Pastor's Message

Dear Parish Family,

[During the week of December 8] we celebrated with our Hispanic communities at All Saints, Sacred Heart, and at St. Martin's with Holy Rosary Bilingual Academy, the Feast of our Lady of Guadalupe. In this Feast, we commemorate the historical event when, in December of 1531, our Blessed Mother appeared to St. Juan Diego and miraculously appeared on his tilma (a cactus fiber tunic). This original image is still on display in the Basilica of Guadalupe in Mexico City, which receives millions of pilgrims each year.

According to the story, our Blessed Mother appeared to St. Juan Diego four times. On December 12th, Juan Diego was looking for a priest to celebrate the last rites for his dying uncle. As he passed Tepeyac hill, the Virgin Mary appeared for the 4th time and called out to him. As he approached her, he found a wide variety of exquisite Castilian roses that were in full bloom. This was truly a miracle, as there were no roses growing naturally in Mexico at that time, and most certainly not in December! Juan Diego picked all the roses he found and folded his tilma over to carry them to the Bishop: this was the sign she had promised.

When he arrived at the bishop's residence, he opened his tilma and the roses dropped out onto the floor. Immediately, the bishop dropped to his knees, not because of the flowers, but because of what was miraculously grafted on his tilma, the image of our Lady. Nearly 500 years later, this very image is on display at the Basilica of Guadalupe.

Within ten years following the apparitions, nearly the entire population of Mexico converted to the Christian Faith, a powerful fruit of this miraculous event. It is the single most successful evangelization event in the Church's history.

Our Lady of Guadalupe,
Mother of all of the Americas, pray for us!

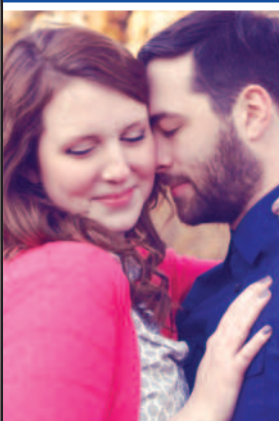
