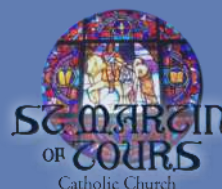

Pastor's Message

[first appeared in January 15 Parish e-Newsletter]

Dear Parish Family,

Earlier this week, in one of our weekday Masses [January 14], we heard the reading from 1 Samuel in which the prophet Samuel received his call to serve the Lord. In the Old Testament tradition, prophets always responded to a call by the Lord to serve in prophetic ministry. In this account from 1 Samuel, Samuel is a minister or apprentice of Eli, a High Priest and one of the last Judges of Israel.

Samuel, asleep in the temple area, hears a voice calling him. He assumes that it is Eli, so he goes to him and says, "Here I am." Eli sends him off as it was not him calling Samuel. This repeats twice more, and in the third instance, Eli understands that it was the Lord calling Samuel. He instructs him that when the Lord calls again, say, "Speak, for your servant is listening." Sure enough, the Lord calls Samuel a fourth time, and Samuel does what Eli instructed him to do, and at that moment, his prophetic ministry begins as he responds affirmatively to the Lord's call in his life.

In so many ways, this story illustrates how the Lord continues to call forth vocations to the priesthood and religious life today. A calling begins with a voice or desire within a young person's heart (the voice of conscience), with the Lord speaking to them in that interior space. As with the example of Eli, the Lord also speaks through people around the young person, inviting them to consider priesthood or religious life: "You would make a great priest/religious/sister; have you thought or prayed about this?" In short, calling forth vocations to the priesthood and religious life is a task that entails all of us!

I am very excited that our Parish Family has a newly-formed Vocation Ministry (made up of members of our Family) to lead the charge, fostering a culture of vocations and providing resources for us. One of the events that they are helping to organize is the Called by Name campaign. You can find information about this in this [month]'s Bulletin and [January 15] e-Newsletter. In short, it is an opportunity for us to consider young people we know who may have a vocation and to nominate them to the Church. They will be contacted and invited to participate in a vocational dinner later in the year.

Let's all pray to the Holy Spirit to inspire us with many names of young people around us, within whom we sense a religious vocation!

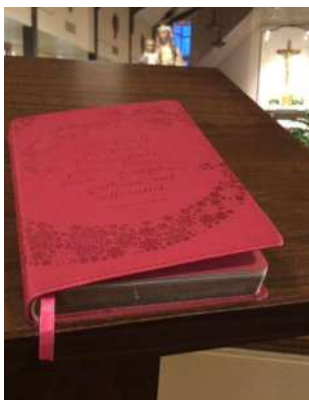

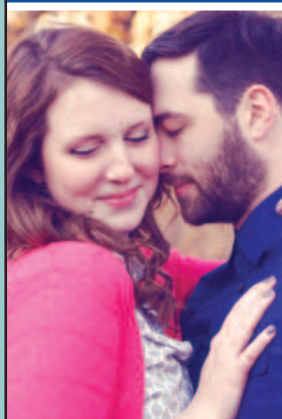
