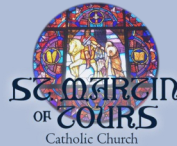

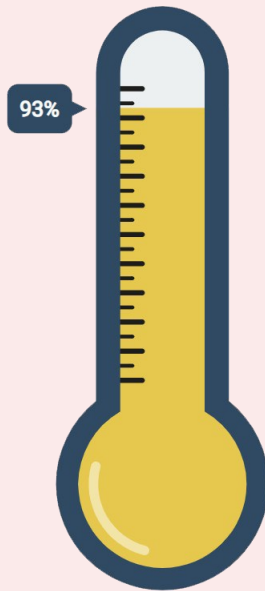

## Pastor's Message

*(first appeared in April 30 Parish e-Newsletter)*

Dear Parish Family,

One of the blessings of working and ministering within our Parish Family is the privilege of co-laboring with our Parishes' permanent deacons. Our deacons in all three of our worship sites—Deacons Mauricio, Dan and Pat—serve in many ways, either publicly at Mass and other liturgical celebrations, in more hidden ways through spiritual direction or pastoral counseling with individuals or families, or through other ministries.

Within the Sacrament of Holy Orders, there exist three levels or grades of ordination. The first is diaconal ordination; the second is priestly ordination; and the third is the fullness of sacramental ordination, episcopal ordination. The word 'deacon' emerges from the Greek word *diakonia*, meaning to serve. A deacon is ordained to serve and therefore reflects in a beautiful way the Sacrament of Holy Orders, which is one of the two Sacraments of service, together with Holy Matrimony.

The First Reading for this 5th Sunday of Easter [May 3] is taken from Acts, Chapter 6, and records what tradition has long held, the ordination or

consecration of the first deacons in the Church: Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, Nicholas, and Stephen the Martyr. The office of deacon continued for many centuries in the Church, but in the medieval period, it began to disappear. Vatican II, held in the 1960s, opened the door to the restoration of the permanent diaconate, distinguished from the transitional diaconate, to which all priests are first ordained prior to their priestly ordination (often six months to a year prior).

In the decades following the Second Vatican Council, the Archdiocese of Seattle has been blessed by the ministry of permanent deacons. They serve us in our local parishes, in our hospitals, in our schools, in our prisons, and on our streets, ministering to the poor. By their ordination, they are configured to Christ to serve as a bridge between the Gospel and the world. Through lives of holiness exemplified by charity, deacons are evangelical missionaries who proclaim the Good News of Jesus Christ by word and deed from the rooftops to the alleyways.

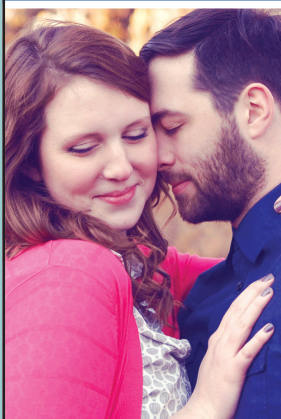
