ABOUT OUR RETREAT SPEAKER



Matt Tyler (ThM, The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary) is the Lead Pastor of Bangkok City Baptist Church in Thailand, an English-speaking church planted in August 2021. He is also a missionary with Reaching and Teaching International Ministries and a founding board member of the Saphan Siam Foundation, a ministry dedicated to strengthening Thai churches through biblical resources. He and his wife, Emily, are always joyfully tired due to their three energetic and crazy boys: Samuel (7), Calvin (6), and Owen (2). The baby of the family, Lucy, tries to calm things down.

SESSION 1—SATURDAY MORNING

“Jesus Serves You” Mark 10:45 (NIV)

⁴⁵ “For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.”

Discussion questions

1. Mark 10:45—What surprises you most about this statement? Consider what it says about God’s character and how it contrasts with how power is typically used in the world.
2. Read Mark 10:35-45 together. What misunderstandings do the disciples have about greatness, and how does Jesus correct them? How does this help you rethink what “success” or “importance” looks like as a Christian?
3. Matt mentioned 8 ways Jesus serves us: Jesus creates you, sustains you, reveals God, teaches what God wants us to know, redeems, intercedes, gives gifts, and will serve us forever. Which of these aspects of Jesus’ service is hardest for you to believe or remember in daily life? Why?

SESSION 1—SATURDAY MORNING

“Jesus Serves You” Mark 10:45 (NIV)

4. Think about a moment in the Gospels where Jesus served someone personally (for example, the Samaritan woman in John 4, washing the disciples feet in John 13, one of his healing miracles such as in Mark 10:46-52, etc.) Read that passage together. What does that moment reveal about the heart of God?
5. Jesus didn't serve us so we can pay him back. Where do you see “transactional relationships” in your life, and what changes when you remember that Jesus serves you freely?
6. Read Philippians 2:3-8. How does Jesus' humility speak into areas of pride or entitlement in your own heart?
7. How does remembering that Jesus continues to intercede for you (Romans 8:33-35; Hebrews 7:25) change the way you view prayer, guilt or spiritual weakness? (How might this truth give you rest instead of pressure?)

SESSION 2—SATURDAY AFTERNOON

Scripture passage—Ephesians 4:1-16 (NIV)

¹ As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received. ² Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love. ³ Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace. ⁴ There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called; ⁵ one Lord, one faith, one baptism; ⁶ one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.

⁷ But to each one of us grace has been given as Christ apportioned it. ⁸ This is why it says:

“When he ascended on high,
he took many captives
and gave gifts to his people.”

⁹ (What does “he ascended” mean except that he also descended to the lower, earthly regions? ¹⁰ He who descended is the very one who ascended higher than all the heavens, in order to fill the whole universe.)

SESSION 2—SATURDAY AFTERNOON

Ephesians 4:1-16 (NIV)

¹¹ So Christ himself gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers, ¹²to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up ¹³until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.

¹⁴Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of people in their deceitful scheming. ¹⁵Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ. ¹⁶From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work.

SESSION 2—SATURDAY AFTERNOON

“Jesus Equips You To Serve” Ephesians 4:1-16 (NIV)

Discussion questions

1. How does the imagery of the body (verses 4-6) help us understand unity and diversity in the church? What are specific ways you can help preserve the unity that the Spirit has given ECC?
2. Verses 11-12 say that leaders equip the saints for ministry. How does this shift responsibility from “a few leaders serve the church” to “every member serves?”
3. According to verses 13-16, what is the goal of all this equipping and serving? Where do you see that happening in our church? Where do you long to see it more?
4. What are some barriers that prevent people from using their gifts in the church? What might help overcome those?
5. How has someone in the church helped you grow spiritually?

SESSION 3—SUNDAY SERVICE

Scripture reading—Romans 12:3-16 (NIV)

³ For by the grace given me I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the faith God has distributed to each of you. ⁴ For just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, ⁵ so in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others. ⁶ We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of us. If your gift is prophesying, then prophesy in accordance with your faith; ⁷ if it is serving, then serve; if it is teaching, then teach; ⁸ if it is to encourage, then give encouragement; if it is giving, then give generously; if it is to lead, do it diligently; if it is to show mercy, do it cheerfully. ⁹ Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good. ¹⁰ Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves. ¹¹ Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord. ¹² Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer. ¹³ Share with the Lord's people who are in need. Practice hospitality. ¹⁴ Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse. ¹⁵ Rejoice with those who rejoice; mourn with those who mourn. ¹⁶ Live in harmony with one another. Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low position. Do not be conceited.

SESSION 3—SUNDAY SERVICE

“How To Serve The Church” Romans 12:3-16 (NIV)

Discussion questions

1. How does remembering that your gifts are given by grace—not earned—change the way you serve others?
2. Romans 12:9 says, “Love must be sincere.” What does sincere, grace-motivated love look like? In what ways have you experienced sincere love at ECC?
3. When have you seen another believer “Joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer (verse 12)?” How did their perseverance help strengthen your faith?
4. Paul commands hospitality and practical generosity (verse 13). What are some real-life barriers that keep us from opening our homes or sharing our resources? What would it look like to take a small step toward practicing hospitality this month?

SESSION 3—SUNDAY SERVICE

5. What specific actions can you take in the coming weeks to “love one another with brotherly love, honor one another above yourselves, rejoice with those who rejoice, mourn with those who mourn, and/or live in harmony with one another?”

6. “Rejoice with those who rejoice; mourn with those who mourn. (Verse 15).” Which of these is harder for you personally, and why? What does this reveal about where God might be stretching your love for others?

7. Take some time to pray for one another. Begin by praising God for all the way he serves and cares for you. Then ask God to help one another and the church as a whole grow in grace-motivated service towards one another.

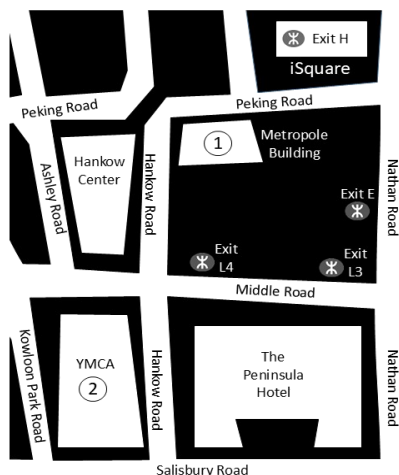

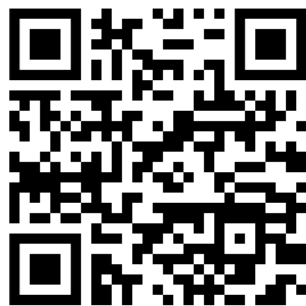
