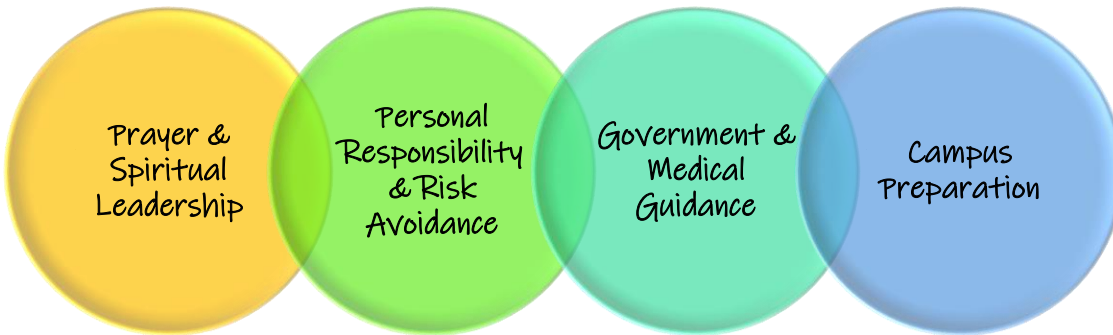


ReGathering @ Crossroads "The New Abnormal"



Sunday Mornings: What to Expect on June 14th And Future Sundays This Summer

50-minute services (initially): 9-9:50 a.m. 11-11:50 a.m. 6-6:50 p.m. (identical to the a.m. services)	6-feet social distancing - Every other pew will be roped off. - There will not be a meet-and-greet time.
Seating will be limited to 130 in the Worship Center. Please arrive no earlier than 15 minutes prior to the service. - Please register online at crossroadsbaptist.com/worship to ensure the attendance at our services is balanced and does not exceed capacity.	No-touch environment - There will not be any bulletins, pens, envelopes, Bibles, hymnals, or candy available. - We recommend you bring your own, if needed.
Those considered within "Vulnerable Populations"¹ must decide for themselves what level of risk they want to take.	No childcare or Connect Groups will be available on campus (initially). - Adult Connect Groups will continue on Zoom.
Cleaning of commonly touched surfaces, pews, and bathrooms will be conducted between services by volunteers.	Masks are optional. - There will be some masks (and hand sanitizer dispensers) available near the doors.
Giving can be done online or via collection boxes placed near the doors.	Praise Team will lead worship. - There will be no choir or orchestra for now.
Bus transportation will be available via reservation.	Commitment Times (membership, baptism, counseling, etc.) will be conducted digitally.

¹ Vulnerable Populations are 1) Older (65+) individuals and 2) individuals with serious underlying health conditions, including high blood pressure, chronic lung disease, diabetes, obesity, asthma, and those whose immune system is compromised (e.g. by chemotherapy, cancer, or other conditions requiring such therapy).
