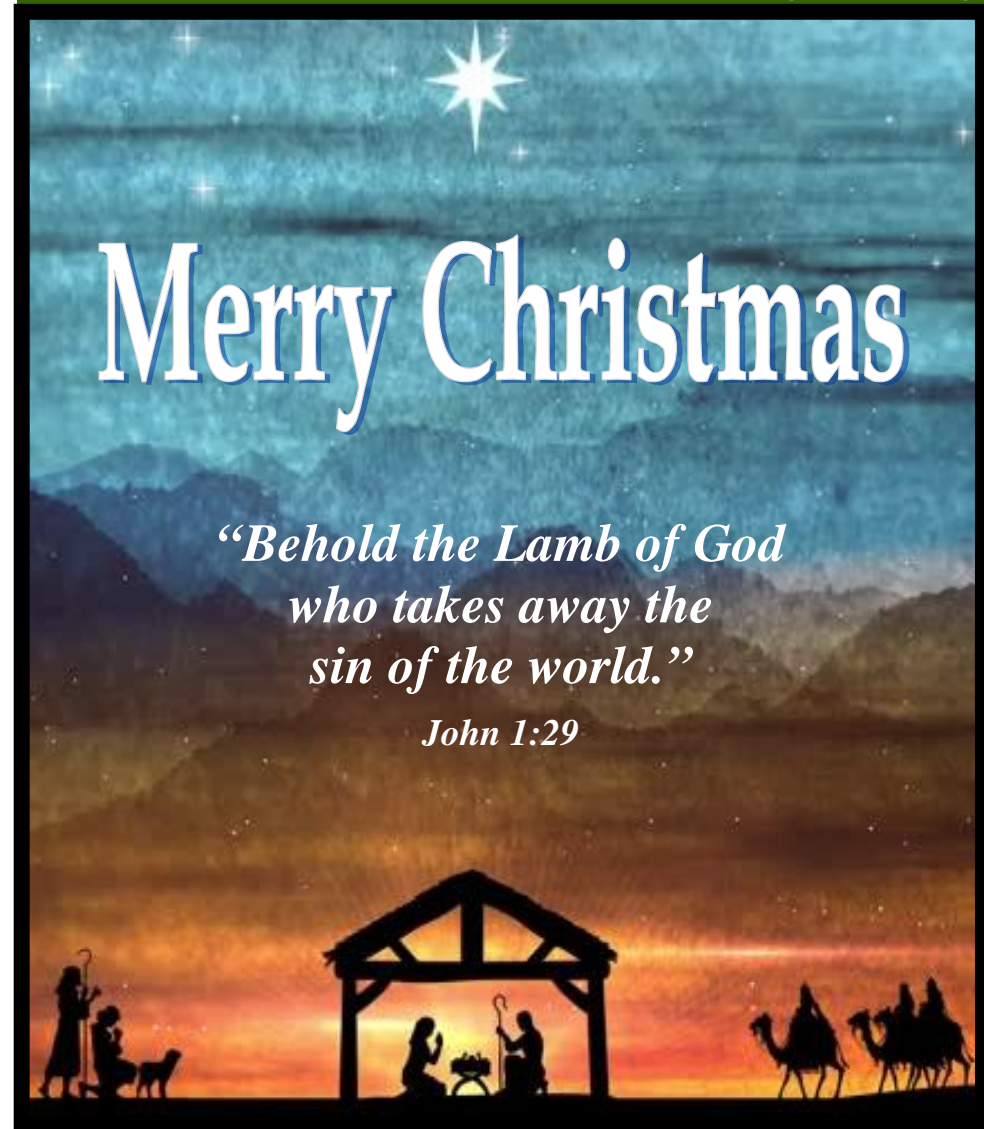

F260 BIBLE READING PLAN

As a church family we will be reading through the Bible in 2018. The F260 is a two hundred and sixty-day reading plan that highlights the foundational passages of Scripture that every disciple should know. The plan calls for believers to read 1 or 2 chapters a day for 5 days each week, with an allowance for weekends off. The 2 off-days each week are built-in so you may catch up on days where you're unable to read. In order to digest more of the Word, the F260 encourages believers to read less than other bible reading plans and to keep a H.E.A.R. Journal (H=Hear, E=Explain, A=Apply, R=Respond). Memory verses are also included and all are encouraged to memorize.

Copies of the reading plan are available on the information board. A "Foundations" book, by Robby and Kandi Gallaty, may be purchased for further study, but is not necessary for reading through the Bible in 2018.

This book may be purchased at Lifeway, Amazon or on iBooks. It is currently \$12.99 at both Lifeway and Amazon. Download "Replicate" App on your smartphone or download more information at replicate.org/f260-bible-reading-play.
