OPENING DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

GROUP LESSON DISCUSSION

1. Read: James 4:13-17NLT. Why should we not boast or be self-confident about tomorrow? What should we say when considering plans for “tomorrow”?
2. Are you living as if tomorrow is/ is not promised?
3. If “tomorrow” does not come, where will you spend eternity? What is the promise for Believers in John 3:16-19 NLT?

Reflection:

Tomorrow isn’t promised but where we spend eternal life is (John 3:16-19 NLT). If you have not given your life to Christ, will you do so today? In caring for the things of your life in this world, will you also care for your eternal life too, Romans 10:9-13 NIV.

Prayer:

Collectively pray for those within your group and those that you personally know who have not yet made the decision for Christ. Pray for the things that you have scheduled for “tomorrow” that you know God is leading you to do “today”.
