## **Phase 1 – Red (Where we are now)**

Virtual Worship Service at 10 am on Sunday mornings  
Devotions Live-Streamed online at 9am on Weekdays  
Virtual Prayer Service at 6:30pm on Wednesdays  
No Large Group Meetings in the Church Building  
No Small Group Meetings in the Church Building  
Ministry Staff working off-site at Home through-out the week
