

## WELCOME TO 4<sup>TH</sup> GRADE!

I am delighted to welcome your child to fourth grade. This year offers many opportunities to learn more about our state and its history. It is fun to teach and also fun to learn. I hope you are looking forward to it as much as I am!

To make a smoother start of school, there are some school supplies that are necessary. Each student will need to have the following items (labeled with your child's name) available in the classroom at all times beginning on the first day of school:

### 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Supply List (PLEASE GET THESE EXACT ITEMS)

- 1 or 1½ inch 3-ring (hard-cover) binder with clear plastic opening in front (no zip-up, fabric, etc. binders)
  - Wide-ruled binder paper (this will need to be replenished all through the year)
  - 1 package of 5 binder dividers
  - 10 pencils (this also will need to be replenished all through the year)
  - 1 large eraser
  - 1 pair of scissors
  - 1 Ruler with both inches and centimeters
  - 1 Glue stick AND 1 small white glue bottle
  - 1 box of crayons or colored pencils
  - 1 box of markers
  - 1 Pencil box (that will fit INSIDE student's desk)
  - 3 spiral notebooks
  - 1 composition notebook (usually has a black and white cover; not spiral-bound)
  - 2 red pens
  - 2 Highlighters
  - 1 package (about 5) BLUE or BLACK erasable pens
  - 1 Backpack WITHOUT wheels!
  - 1 box of tissues (to share with class)
  - 1 package of disinfecting wipes (to share with class)
  - 1 pump-bottle of hand sanitizer (not soap, to share with class)
  - 1 chapter book/novel to remain in student's desk that student will enjoy reading (this will also need to be replaced throughout the year as students finish reading)
    - IF YOUR LAST NAME IS A-L: 1 Box Ziploc Bags—Sandwich Size
    - IF YOUR LAST NAME IS M-Z: 1 Box Ziploc Bags—Snack Size(To be shared with whole class throughout year)
- For shared school-wide use in our ESCS STEAM Room:
- 1 package of balloons, or pipe cleaners, or sponges, or toothpicks, or large popsicle sticks
