

PARENT SUPPORT CONTRACT

Parental support is a major factor in the success of El Sobrante Christian School. We ask that each parent and/or guardian read and initial the parent pledges shown below as part of the enrollment process.

- A. _____ I give permission for my child to take part in all school activities, including sports and school-sponsored trips away from the school premises. Provided reasonable care has been taken, I absolve the school from any liability due to injury to me or my child while at school or during any school activity.
- B. _____ I promise to encourage obedience to the rules of the school and foster an attitude of respect for the Christian culture and life, which are maintained at this school.
- C. _____ I understand that school standards do not tolerate profanity, obscenity in word or action, dishonor to God or the Word of God or disrespect to the school and any/all personnel.
- D. _____ I agree to abide by the school's disciplinary policy. If after reasonable effort has been made to discipline my child and to assist his/her academic adjustment, he/she does not comply with the standards of the school; I agree to withdraw him/her from the school.
- E. _____ I agree to conform to the requirements of the school in regard to dress and personal grooming for my child and will support the administration in maintaining the decorum of the school with respect to my child.
- F. _____ We agree that if there is damage to school property that it will be assessed and charged to our Account should our child be responsible for the damage.
- G. _____ I agree to pay the tuition and all fees according to arrangements made on the school tuition policy, and to conclude all required payments before the last day of school. I understand that monthly tuition payments are due on the first of each month and are late after the 15th. A \$50 late fee will be charged on all late payments.
- H. _____ Tuition for withdrawals and late enrollment during the school year will be billed as follows: A two (2) week notice is REQUIRED. If less than two weeks notice is given, tuition charges may be levied. Tuition will be calculated on a per diem basis for days enrolled, taking the two (2) week notice into consideration.
- I. _____ Returned Checks: Checks that are returned from the bank are subject to a charge of \$40. After two returned checks in a school year, further payments must be made in cash, with a cashier's check, or money order.
- J. _____ I understand that *if my tuition account becomes more than 30 days past due my child(ren) will be excluded from classes* until paid or satisfactory arrangements are made with the ESCS Finance Committee.
- K. _____ Parent Service Requirement of 15 units is required annually. I understand that a \$100 deposit is required annually by September 1st. If the annual requirement of 15 units is fulfilled, the \$100 fee can be applied to the next school year. See The Parent Policy Handbook for details.
- L. _____ We agree to and understand all of the policies, directives and requirements of the ESCS Parent-Student Handbook(s).
