LOVE OTHERS – JOHN 13:34 ESV

***A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another:
just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another.***

- 1. What are some things you like to do or want to do?** What are some things you don't like to do or don't want to do? WHY is it easier to do what we like to do, or what we want to do, versus what we don't like to do, or don't want to do?
- 2. What is the command that Jesus gives His disciples in John 13:34?**
 - a. To love one another just as He has loved us!
 - b. Is this command easy or hard.... or impossible?
- 3. What are ways we show love to one another?**
 - a. Serve one another, put others needs before our own, UB4ME. Phil 2:3-4
 - b. Encourage one another and build each other UP. 1 Thess 5:11
 - c. Forgive one another Eph 4:32
- 4. How can we love each other when really, it's impossible?**
 - a. Love as Jesus has loved you John 13:34
 - b. We CAN'T love the way Jesus as loved us without Jesus working first in your heart
 - c. Love with the humility of Jesus Phil 2:3-4
 - d. Love even when it is undeserved – we all fail!
 - e. Jesus loved us and forgave us, and we didn't deserve it.
- 5. How can I experience the love of Jesus first?**
 - a. Romans 3:23 For all have sinned! Recognize your need for Jesus' love and forgiveness!
 - b. Romans 5:8, Romans 6:23 You can't be good enough to earn Jesus' love and forgiveness!
 - c. John 3:16 For God SO LOVED... WHOEVER believes receives eternal life
