## **Registration Instructions**

Registration should be completed as soon as possible to reserve your spot for summer camp. Spots are subject to availability after May 1st and will incur a \$25 late fee by the camp. All registrations must be completed online this year. Should you need access to internet or a computer, please stop by FBC or contact one of the camp coordinators. A parent or guardian must register their child for camp, not the participating child.

- 1. Go to https://hlccc.org/camper-info-journey-camp/
- 2. Click the orange button that says "Register or Login."
- 3. If you have never registered for a camp at Highland Lakes before, create a new account. You may need to verify your email address and repeat the previous steps above after your account is created. **This account needs to be in the name of the parent/guardian, not the child!** You will enter the child's information after the parent/guardian info is submitted. After you have made an account, login.
- 4. After logging in, if you do not see your child's name listed in the Current Camper(s), click the green button to "Add Camper." If your child's name is listed in the Current Camper(s), click the "Register (New)" button next to their name.
- 5. Click "Yes" when asked if you are registering with a GHR ID and enter the code **24fbclexington**. If you do not use this code you will not be registering with our group!
- 6. Complete all the available forms: Registration, Medical, and Liability. You can view the forms by clicking the "account" tab and then clicking "Forms." If you see a red bell notification icon, that means you still have forms to complete.
- 7. If you intend on bringing medications to camp, make sure to also fill out the attached Medication Administration Form. This form will need to be brought with your child in a gallon-sized plastic bag with all their necessary medications in their original containers inside the bag as well on the day they leave for camp.
- 8. Once you complete the forms, you're registered! Just make sure to submit payments to the church before May 1st!

Personal Hygiene Items: Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Brush, Comb, Shampoo, Soap, Deodorant, etc.

### WHAT NOT TO BRING ITEMS

Food Items: they can attracts ants in the bunkhouses
Keepsakes or any Valuables

Prank Supplies e.g. body paint, glitter, confetti, water balloons, water guns, etc
Illegal Drugs, Alcohol, or Tobacco of any kind including vapes and e-cigs.
Fireworks, Matches, Lighters, Firearms, or Weapons of any kind
Clothing with questionable sayings and slogans or that is immodest, short, or tight-fitting - Refer to HLC GENERAL CAMP RULES
Anything that promotes racism, sexism, or hatred of any group or person

Students are asked to refrain from bringing their cell phones to camp. All phones will be collected and stored in a lockbox once we arrive. #### **MEDICATION ADMINISTRATION FORM**

- All medication must be turned in to Highland Lakes Camp Medical Staff.
- · List all medications on this form.
- Put this form and the medications listed in a sealable plastic bag.
- Write the camper name and church name on the bag.
- Give the bag to the group leader.
- Prescription medication must be properly labeled. If dosage on the container is different than what is to be given, a doctor's note must accompany the prescription with current instructions.
- No medication will be given unless they are in original containers per Texas Department of State Health Services.
- Highland Lakes Camp Medical Staff request that you do not send Over-the-Counter medications e.g. Tylenol, Ibuprofen, Benadryl, etc. These types of medications are provided by HLCCC.
